ERASMUS+

The **Erasmus+** Programme 2021-2027 is the EU Programme addressed to the following sectors:

- Education;
- Training;
- Youth and Sport.

The programme is focused on 3 key activities and the first one is called *Key action 1:* **Learning Mobility of Individuals.**

Student mobility programme, included in the Key Action 1, is subdivided in:

- Student Mobility for studies
- Student Mobility for Traineeship

Key issues such as **social inclusion**, **environmental sustainability**, **digital transition** and promotion of **participation** in democratic life by the younger generation have a central role in the **Erasmus+** Programme 2021-2027.

Students may thus experience international academic and working realities, by attending courses and taking exams in a university abroad and by undertaking traineeship activities in a company abroad.

To obtain the grant, students are expected to apply in compliance with the criteria of Call for Student Mobilities for Studies and for Traineeships Mobilities.

1. Student Mobility for studies

Students may participate in a Mobility for studies abroad spending from 2 up to 12 months (including the traineeship period), starting from the first year of study, at a university located in one of the foreign countries which signed an Erasmus+ Interinstitutional Agreement with the Sending University

For the one-cycle degree programs, such as Law, the students may benefit from a mobility period of up to 24 months.

The Mobility for studies period spent at other university allows students to attend courses and benefit from the facilities available at the Receiving Institution, without paying additional tuition fees, and by ensuring the recognition of the period of study abroad in terms of ECTS transfer of credits: European Credit Transfer System.

Erasmus students may receive a grant as economic contribution or benefit from the Erasmus+ status (without scholarship). In both cases, students have the possibility to attend courses and visit

facilities available at the Receiving university without paying additional tuition fees; also, during the mobility period students are entitled to receive scholarships and/or national loans.

2. Student Mobility for Traineeship

Students may participate in a Traineeship mobility period spending from 2 up to 12 months in companies, training and research centres, except for European Institutions or Organisations, which deal with European programmes in one of the European Countries participating in the Programme and starting from the first year of study.

Students may participate in a Traineeship mobility period spending up to 12 months for each study course; for the one-cycle study courses, such as Law, students can benefit from a mobility period of up to 24 months.

In order to ensure its quality, the Mobility period shall be in line with the academic path of the student and his/her personal goals.

As for the Mobility for studies, also for Traineeship Erasmus students may receive a grant as economic contribution or benefit from the Erasmus+ status (without scholarship); in both cases, during the mobility period students are entitled to receive scholarships and/or national loans.
